Heard Mr.A.R.Tahbildar, learned Counsel appearing for the applicant and Mr.P.K.Garodia, learned CGSC, assisted by Capt Nisha Thomas, OIC, AFT Cell, appearing for the respondents.</p> <p>2. Lt.Col S.K.Bhalla, Chief Records Officer, Assam Regimental Records, Shillong appears and submits that the case for compliance of order dated 11.05.2018 passed by this Tribunal in OA-30 of 2016 was processed from the Record Office to the Service Head Quarter and PS-4 is the Directorate which is the Directorate at the service Head Quarters which processes the case and further disposal of the case for compliance of this Tribunal's order is not known to him. However, he also submits that he is aware that a SLP has been filed in the Hon'ble Supreme Court in this regard and when queried whether any stay order has been obtained in this regard, Lt.Col S.K.Bhalla submits that no stay has been obtained.</p> <p>3.
