1. Heard Mr.A.R.Tahbildar, learned counsel appearing for the applicant and Brig.N.Deka(Retd), learned CGSC appearing for the respondents.
2. While filing this application, the applicant has prayed for condonation of delay of 2 years 4 months in filing the connected MA-05/2018 seeking leave to appeal against the Judgment and Order dated 1.10.2015 passed in OA-08-2014.
3. The applicant was convicted under section 69 of the Army Act for committing offence under section 302 IPC and sentenced to imprisonment for life as well as dismissal from service. The sentence was upheld by this Tribunal in the said OA i.e. OA -08/2014.

4. We find that Armed Forces Tribunal has no authority to condone the delay. Moreover, the matter does not involve any point of law of general public importance. Therefore, the prayer for condonation of delay is rejected and MA stands dismissed.
