1. Heard Mr.A.R.Tahbildar, learned counsel appearing for the applicant and Brig.N.Deka(Retd), learned CGSC appearing for the respondents.
2. While filing this application, the applicant has sought for leave to appeal before the Hon'ble Supreme Court against the Judgment and Order dated 1.10.2015 passed by this Tribunal in OA-08-2014.
3. The applicant was convicted under section 69 of the Army Act for committing offence under section 302 IPC and sentenced to imprisonment for live as well as dismissal from service. The sentence was upheld by this Tribunal in the said OA i.e. OA -08/2014.

4. We do not find any point of law of general public importance is involved in it for granting leave to appeal under section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. It thus stands declined.

5. In view of the above the MA stands dismissed.
