Sharma, learned counsel appearing for the applicant and Mr. P. Sharma, learned CGSC assisted by Capt Nisha Thomas, OIC, Legal Cell, AFT, Guwahati appearing for the respondents.</p> <p>2. Learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that no PPO has been issued to the applicant despite ADGPS letter dated 28.05.2014 (Annexure-1) at page 11 of</p>

the OA.

3. OIC, AFT Legal Cell, Guwahati submits before the Bench, a letter from PCDA (P) dated 09.04.2019 addressed to her office i.e. AFT Legal Cell, HQ 51 Sub Area in which we observe that certain clarification and documents were sought from both PCDA (O) as well as from the applicant.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that no such correspondence has been received from the office of PCDA (P) by him and hence the PPO has not been issued as yet.

5. We observe that there is obviously some communication gap in this matter.

6. The respondents, in particular, the PCDA(P) is directed to issue a fresh letter to the applicant by registered post communicating what exact documents are to be furnished by him. Copy of this letter will be filed by the respondent's counsel before the next date. PCDA (P) is also directed to obtain the necessary clarifications from PCDA (O) and resolve the issue expeditiously by issuing PPO at the earliest.

7. List the case for order whenever the next Division Bench reassembles.
