Sharma, learned CGSC assisted by Capt Nisha Thomas, OIC, Legal Cell, AFT, Guwahati appearing for the respondents.</p> <p>2. Perused the order dated 08.05.2019, wherein the PCDA(P) was directed to issue a fresh letter to the applicant by registered post communicating what exact documents are to be furnished by him. PCDA (P) was also directed to obtain necessary clarification from the PCDA(O) in the matter. Capt Nisha Thomas, OIC, Legal Cell, AFT, Guwahati submits that she has communicated to the PCDA, but no response has been given.</p> <p>3. On 06.06.2019, PCDA (P) failed to communicate as to what exact documents are required to be furnished by the applicant. Vide the said order dated 06.06.2019, PCDA(P) was directed to depute a suitable representative</p>

along with the letter indicating details as shown in Para 6 of the order dated 08.05.2019. But neither any communication has been received nor any representative from PCDA(P) has appeared before this Tribunal.

4. Issue show-cause notice to PCDA(P) asking him to explain as to why suitable legal action may not be initiated for violation of the order of this Tribunal.

5. Registry is directed to communicate the PCDA(P) as well as the learned counsel for the party concerned at least 7-10 days in advance about sitting of this Tribunal.

6. List the matter whenever the next Division Bench reassembles.
