Heard the applicant in person and Brig N. Deka (Retd), learned CGSC appearing for the respondents. 2. Brig N. Deka (Retd) learned CGSC, appearing for the respondents submits that though the respondents have filed limited counter raising the issue relating to the maintainability of the present OA in the AFT, the counter on merit has not been filed. 3.
