Standing Counsel assisted by Col Anand, OIC, AFT Legal Cell appearing for the respondents submit that as per the intimation received from the MS Branch, the statutory complaint has already been disposed of by the MoD, copy of which, however, has not been received either by the learned CGSC or Col Anand.
