Heard Mr. AR Tahbildar, learned counsel appearing for the applicant and Col Anand, OIC, Legal Cell, AFT, Guwahati appearing for the respondents. 2. The applicant has filed this MA seeking condonation of delay in filing the OA claiming the benefit of disability element of the pension contending inter-alia that since the claim for disability pension is based on continuous cause of action, which arises every month, the delay needs to be condoned. 3. Having heard the learned counsel and upon perusal of the averments made in the applicant and also the claim of the applicant made in the OA which is for disability element of the pension, we are of the considered opinion that since the claim in the OA is based on the continuous cause of action, which arises every month, the MA needs to be disposed of with the

observation that in case the applicant is found to be entitled to the claim made in the OA, the arrear may be restricted for a period of 03 years preceedig the date of filing of the OA.

4. MA is accordingly disposed of.
