The applicant has filed this O.A. challenging the order issued in the month of April, 2016 (Annexure-C) rejecting the claim of the applicant for family pension, contending, inter alia, that though the applicant's husband has rendered more than 15 years embodied service in the territorial army, the claim for family pension has been denied wrongly.</p> <p>3. In view of the aforesaid contention of the applicant, issue notice on the respondents.</p> <p>4. Since the respondents are represented by Brig. N.Deka, learned Central Govt. Standing Counsel, no fresh notice need be issued.</p> <p>5. The respondents, within six weeks from now, shall file their affidavit disclosing the period of embodied service of the applicant's husband in the territorial army. In the said affidavit the reason for rejection of the family pension</p>

to the applicant shall also be disclosed.

6. The applicant may file rejoinder, if any, within two weeks thereafter.

7. List for orders on 28.11.2016 when attempt may be made to take up the O.A. for final disposal.
