N.Deka, learned Counsel appearing for the respondents on instruction has submitted that the Second Appeal preferred by the applicant on 5 th March, 2016 could not be disposed till date, as the medical records pertaining to the applicant was lost in the Office of the PCDA, Allahabad, which, however, was subsequently |
