The respondents may file a dditional affidavit if so advised against the amended portion of the O.A.</p> <p>3. The respondents, within 6 (six) weeks from now, shall file their counter affidavit.</p> <p>4. Heard Mr. U.Sarma, learned Counsel for the applicant</p>

and Mr. C.Barua, learned Central Govt. Standing Counsel assisted by Col Anand, OIC, AFT Legal Cell, Guwahati on the prayer for interim order.

1. Having heard the learned Counsel appearing for the parties and upon perusal of the averments made in the O.A., as amended, we are not inclined to pass any interim order, as asked for in the O.A., as it would amount to stopping conduct of fresh promotion boards and promotion of empanelled officers.

2. However, any promotions made, shall be subject to reliefs, if any granted to the applicant based on the outcome of the O.A.

3. The respondents shall within 6 (six) weeks from now file their counter.

4. The applicant may file rejoinder, if any, 2 (two) weeks thereafter.

5. Post it for order on 30.01.2017.
