

3. Mr. Barua, learned Counsel appearing for the respondent No. 1 to 5 have submitted that the amount due and payable towards the commuted amount of pension has, in terms of the interim order dated 03.03.2016, not been directed to be released in favour of the respondent No. 6 and in respect of the other retiral benefits PPO has been issued and the amount would be credited in the respondent No. 6's bank account.

4. Having regard to the aforesaid submissions advanced, we adjourn the case till 20.08.2016, when the applicant and the respondent No. 6 shall apprise this Tribunal about the payment of the aforesaid amount of Rs. 5 (five) lakhs to the applicant.

5. Needless to say that the respondent No. 6 shall be paid all the retiral benefits except the commuted amount of pension, as directed vide order dated 03.03.2016.
