Having heard the learned Counsel for the parties and upon perusal of the averments made in the application and also taking note of the claim of the applicant in the OA which is for disability pension as well as for service pension, we are of the view that the M.A. needs to be disposed of with the observation that in case the applicant is found to be entitled to disability pension as well as service pension, as claimed in the O.A., he would be entitled to the arrear for a period of 3 (three) years</p>
