It has also been submitted that the order dated 1 st September, 2004 was never issued and even was not in existence at the time of filing of counter affidavit by the respondents in W.P.(C) No. 783/2005 before the Hon`ble Gauhati High Court, which is nothing but subsequently manufactured document. Learned Counsel for the parties have also advanced their arguments on the merits of this case. To appreciate the rival contentions the relevant records are required to be perused. Hence, the respondents shall, on the next date fixed, produce the relevant records for perusal by this Tribunal.
