We find that the speaking order has not been passed in light of the directions issued by this Tribunal on 03.02.2020 in M.A(E) 13/2021 arising out of O.A No.23 of 2019. In Para 5 of the order passed, after considering the statutory regulations and the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Union of India and another v. In spite of detailed order passed on 27.07.2021, it is stated in this case, which is a contempt application, an order passed in O.A No. 37 of 2018 way back on 22.02.2019, has not been complied with. The matter pertains to grant of pensionary benefits to the wife and compensation to her daughter, for reasons indicated in the application. When the matter was taken up on 27.07.2021, we were informed that the order had not been complied with as the respondents proposed to file a Special Leave Petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and in anticipation of filing the SLP, they sought time. In Para 2, we had specifically observed that we do not appreciate the manner in which the respondents are taking action in the matter. It was indicated by us that even if the respondents proposed to file a SLP before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, nothing prevents them from implementing the order and thereafter approaching the SC to seek appropriate relief as may be permissible. We had directed the respondents

to comply with the order and file a compliance report within four weeks. We have also indicated that failure to file the compliance report we would be compelled to take coercive action.

2. Today, when the matter was taken up after three months, learned counsel for the respondents has again sought time stating that the matter has been referred to the Ministry of Defence for instructions and no instructions have so far been received. Taking note of the manner in which the respondents are proceeding with the matter, we direct issuance of notice to Respondent No. 1 and the competent authority of the department viz. Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 in O.A No. 37 of 2018 along with a certified copy of this order, so that the facts of the case are brought to the notice of Respondent No. 1 in this application and Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 in O.A. No. 37 of 2018 and we request them to ensure that the order passed by us is implemented within four weeks and a compliance report is filed, failing which we will proceed with the matter for taking contempt of court action against all responsible persons. We are constrained to pass such order on account of the fact that day in and day out in at least 10 to 15 cases every day which come before the Tribunal we find that the orders passed by this Tribunal are not being implemented and particularly in the matter of grant of pay and allowances to the employees who had retired even after the delay of more than about a year the order has not been complied with. Faced with this situation and finding this case to be a typical case of breach of directions issued by this Tribunal, we are constrained to issue notice not only to the Defence Secretary but also the Chief of Army Staff, so that the manner in which the cases of this Tribunal after orders are passed are

being dealt with are brought to their notice. In case the respondents do not comply with the order by the next date, the officers concerned will be summoned to appear personally before the Principal Bench of the Tribunal at New Delhi for taking further action in the matter.

3. Even though the OIC Legal Cell appeared before us today during the course of hearing and indicated that the papers have been forwarded for settlement of the claim, we are not satisfied with only forwarding the papers and not responding to our queries for more than three months. We want positive action to be taken particularly in case of settlement of pensionary claim of dependents of the employees and therefore even though OIC Legal Cell may be justified in making submission that action is under way but in view of inordinate delay not only in this case but in most of cases that come before us, we are constrained to pass this order.
