2. This MA 33/17 has been filed for condonation of delay of 3 years 6 months in filing the connected O.A. 39/2017.

- 3. The applicant has filed O.A. 39/2017 seeking disability pension. The same has been filed after a delay of 3 years 6 months.
- 4. As the matter pertains to pension, which is an occurring and contining cause of action and in view of the principles laid down by the Hon`ble Apex Court in the Union of India & Ors. Vs. Tarsem Singh, 2008 (8) SCC 648, the delay can be condoned in such matter without attaching much significance to limitation.
- 5. In view of the aforesaid principles laid down by the Hon`ble Apex Court, the delay of 3 years 6 months in filing the O.A. 39/2017 is condoned. However, if the applicant succeeds he will be entitled to a rrears of pension for the period of 3 (three) years prior to the date of filing the Original Application to this Tribunal, i.e. 21.7.2017.
- 5. The Application filed for condonation of delay is allowed.
