	Heard Shri R.K. Singh, Ld. Counsel for the applicants and Shri P.J. Barman, Ld. Counsel for the respondents. This Original Application has been filed for issuing direction to the respondents to reinstate the applicant in service after quashing the termination/dismissal order based on fraudulent enrolment. It is submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicants that applicant is not a case fraudulent enrolment. It is a case of genuine enrolment. There being delay in filing the Original Application, a delay condonation application has been filed separately and it is submitted that delay is not deliberate. As a matter of fact the applicant had approached the District Court for the redressal of his grievance by filing a Title Suit for Domicile Certificate as authentic and genuine which was later dismissed as withdrawn on the ground that it was wrongly filed in that Court.
