1. Heard Mr.Rajiv Sarma, learned counsel appearing for the applicant and Brig N.Deka (Retd), learned CGSC appearing for the respondents.
2. The learned counsel for the application has sought for condonation of delay in filing an appeal on the ground of compelling circumstances under which he left the training camp
3. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the application for condonation of delay.
4. We do not find any cogent reason for condonation of delay in filing the appeal and also that a point of law of general public importance is involved in the decision for filing an appeal before the Hon'ble Supreme Court as per Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007.
