Learned counsel for the applicant has also pointed out to para 13

of judgment pronounced by AFT, RB, Chennai in OA No. 65/2014 as also para 13 of judgment pronounced in OA No. 52/2013 in both of which determination of culpability of applicant through Court of Inquiry had been found improper and if that be so, then applicant could not have been inculpated in GCM proceedings which was held against Col VV Bhaskar.

On perusal of the case, it also appears that there is no document which forms to the basis of Statement of Case against the applicant. Further, no Statement of Case against the applicant is placed on record. Moreover, this Tribunal also seeks to peruse the Selection Board proceedings of each of the instances of 22.09.2021 (Fresh case), March 2022 (First Review case) and Oct 2022 (Final Review case).
