Heard Mr.U.Sarma, learned Counsel appearing for the applicant and Mr.D.C.Chakravarty, learned CGSC, assisted by Col Anand, OIC Legal Cell, appearing for the respondents.</li> <li>2. Having heard the learned Counsel for the parties and upon perusal of the averments made in the application and also the claim of the applicant in the OA, which is for grant of disability pension as well as broad-banding the same, we are of the considered opinion that since such claim is based on a continuing cause of action, the MA needs to be disposed of with the observation that if the applicant is found to be entitled to the relief (s) claimed in the OA, the arrear may be restricted for a period of 3 years preceding the date of filing of the OA or the date of filing of the representation, whichever occurs earlier.</li> <li>3.
