Invoking the jurisdiction of this Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act 2007, the applicant has filed this O.A seeking the following reliefs:

- (i) Admit this petition, call for the records, issue rule calling upon the respondents to show cause as to why original application in the nature of unfair and/or any other appropriate order or direction of like nature shall not be passed directing the respondents authority to release pensionary benefit which was stopped just after three years from date of his discharge; and
- (ii) Upon cause or causes being shown as after hearing the parties and/or pass any other order or orders as the Court may deem fit and proper.
- 2. The facts, in nutshell, indicate that the applicant was enrolled in the Army (Corps of EME) on 13.06.1972 and was discharged from service on 07.07.1975 having been found medically unfit for further service under Item III (iii) of the Table annexed to Rule 13(3) of the Army Rules, 1954. It is the case of the applicant that as he was discharged from service on being found medically unfit for

service, he is entitled to pension and claiming pensionary benefits, this O.A has been filed. Though the applicant was discharged from service on 07.07.1975, the present O.A has been filed only after a period of 54 years and M.A No. 5 of 2020 has been filed for condoning the delay in filing the O.A. While considering the application for admission on 04.02.2020, the following order was passed by this Tribunal:

1. This is a pensionary matter and in case of the pensionary matters, cause of action arises on the last date of every month. Therefore, this Original Application is admitted for hearing. M.A No.05 of 2020 shall be disposed of at the time of final judgment.

3. As the applicant was praying for pensionary benefits and according to the Tribunal, the cause of action for grant of pension arises on the last day of every month, the application was admitted for hearing and the respondents were directed to file their reply. Apart from challenging the inordinate delay in approaching the Tribunal, the respondents contended that the applicant kept quiet for a period of more than 54 years and the documents pertaining to the discharge of the applicant are no more available with the respondents as they have been destroyed by burning on 16.05.2005 being more than 25 years old and a non-pensionable case. The destruction of the documents has taken place in terms of Para 595 of the Regulations for the Army 1987, extract of which has been filed as Annexure R3. The respondents further submit that as per the entry record available in the destruction sheet of the applicant filed as Annexure R1, a sum of Rs.771.75 was credited to the account of the applicant towards Invalid gratuity. It is further stated by the respondents that in the destruction sheet, there is no entry regarding grant of any kind of pensionary benefits to the applicant. There is no entry that the individual has been discharged on medical grounds attributable to medical service. According to the respondents, if the applicant was discharged from service on account of

disability attributable to Military service, he would have been granted disability

pension, but now as he is not entitled to any disability pension he having not

qualified for grant of pensionary benefits in terms of the Pension Regulations,

particularly Regulation 132 of the Regulations for the Army, wherein pension is

payable only to a person who has fifteen years of qualifying service, it is stated that

the applicant is not entitled to any benefit. In the application, except for contending

that he is entitled for pension after serving for a period of 03 years and 18 days, the

applicant has not brought on record any material or document to show that he was

discharged from service on account of any ailment, which was attributable to Military

service.

Taking note of the totality of the circumstances, we are of the

considered view that in this case, the delay of more than 54 years caused by the

applicant has resulted in destruction of all the documents. The documents available

on record only indicate that the applicant had rendered 03 years and 18 days of

service. He has not qualified for grant of pension and there is nothing on record to

show that he was discharged from service on account of any medical disability

which was attributable to Military service.

Taking note of all these circumstances, we see no reasons to grant

any relief or benefit to the applicant. The applicant having miserably failed to prove

his claim for grant of pension, we dismiss the O.A without any order as to costs.

Invoking the jurisdiction of this Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal 2007, the applicant has filed this O.A and the reliefs sought in Para 7 of the O.A read as under:

- (i) Direct/command the respondents to grant pension and pensionary benefits to the applicant taking into account his service for more than 15 years of qualifying service and eligible for pension and pensionary benefits; and
- (ii) Investigate into the matter under Court's observation and after perusal of records of the case be pleased to pass an order granting relief as prayed and/or pass such order/orders as deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.
- 2. The facts, in nutshell, indicate that the applicant joined the Indian Army (Signal Regiment) as Sepoy on 13.10.1979. He was subsequently promoted to the rank of Naik. In 1995, while he was posted at 1<sup>st</sup> Jabalpur (Signal Regiment), 56 APO, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh, he went on leave due to illness of his wife and he was granted leave for 20 days from 19.09.1995 to 09.10.1995 by the authorities. It is

the case of the applicant that during the leave period, his wife died leaving behind a minor child and, therefore, he could not report for duty after the expiry of the leave period. The applicant was discharged from service in terms of Section 23 read with Rules 11 and 12 of the Army Rules. It is the case of the applicant that before his dismissal from service, he had completed 15 years of qualifying service and, therefore, in terms of Regulation 113B of the Regulations for the Army 1961, he is entitled to pensionary benefits and claiming the pensionary benefits, he has invoked the jurisdiction of this Tribunal.

- It is the case of the applicant that after he was dismissed from service 3. on 24.10.2005, he is entitled for the pensionary benefits. On 09.01.1998, he sent a representation in the form of an appeal against his discharge from service and claimed pensionary benefits due to him on the ground that he had served 17 years of service and thereby possessed the qualifying service of 15 years mandatory for entitlement of pension. When nothing was done, he again represented on 28.09.1999 and when nothing happened, he invoked the jurisdiction of this Tribunal in the year 2019 i.e. after 10 years. Contending, inter alia, that the applicant is entitled to pensionary benefits, it is stated that he had filed a writ petition before the Guwahati High Court in the year 2019, but as the High Court did not have jurisdiction, he withdrew the writ petition on 11.01.2019 and filed the present O.A. He also stated that in the light of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Deokinandan Prashad v. State of Bihar and others (AIR 1971 SC 1407) and D.S. Nakara and others v. Union of India (1983 (1) SCC 305), the applicant is entitled to pension and by refusing to grant pension to the applicant, the respondents have committed a grave error.
- 4. On notice being issued, the respondents have filed a detailed reply and the case of the respondents is that the applicant was declared as a deserter with effect from 13.10.1995 and he was dismissed from service under Section 20(3) of the Army Act read with Rule 17 of the Army Rules being a deserter. It is the

further case of the respondents that the applicant had rendered 15 years and 250 days of qualifying service after execution of 84 days of non-qualifying service period. The respondents have also stated that since the applicant did not report for duty, a Court of Inquiry was conducted to inquire into the fact of his desertion with effect from 13.10.1995 vide Annexure R-III. The occurrence of desertion was published in the Part II order dated 17.12.1995 and on 26.06.1996 as per the final settlement account Annexure R4 finalized by the Pay and Accounts Office, Corps of Signal, the applicant was granted terminal credit balance of Rs.5,033/- and AFPP Fund balance of Rs.68,071/-. Even after the final settlement was made in the year 1996, he did not make any representation. According to the respondents, an individual who is dismissed from service under the provisions of the Army Act, 1950 or removed under the Rules made thereunder, as a measure of penalty, will be ineligible for pension or gratuity in respect of all previous services. The applicant was dismissed from service with effect from 24.10.2005 and he was not eligible for pension because his dismissal was under Section 20(3) read with Rule 17 on the ground that he was a deserter. Further, as his dismissal debars him from pension in accordance with Para 41 of the Revised Pension Regulations for the Army Part I (2008), it is the case of the respondents that the applicant is not entitled for any benefit. Para 41 of the revised Pension Regulations for the Army Part I (2008) reads as under:

An individual who is dismissed under provisions of Army Act, 1950 or removed under the rule made thereunder as a measure of penalty, will be ineligible for pension or gratuity in respect of all previous service.

5. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and on consideration of the facts of the case, we find that the applicant has been dismissed from service under Section 20(3) of the Army Act read with Rule 17 of the Army Rules. Section 20 of the Army Act provides for "dismissal, removal or reduction" of a person governed by the Army Act and sub-section (3) of Section 20 provides for dismissal of any person other than an officer or a junior commissioned officer in terms of the

power conferred on the competent authority as detailed therein. The punishment of dismissal from service under Section 20 of the Army Act is by way of punishment for desertion and in this case, after holding a Court of Inquiry, action has been taken not only in terms of Section 20(3) of the Army Act, but also in terms of Rule 17 of the Army Rules, which provides the procedure for "dismissal or removal" of an officer under Section 20(3).

6 In the present case, it is seen that the applicant was dismissed from service under the statutory provisions on 24.10.2005 and till date, the applicant has not challenged the dismissal order. Even in this petition, the applicant claims pensionary benefits on the ground that he has completed the qualifying service. However, no prayer has been made for quashing the order of dismissal from service. Dismissal from service of the applicant is by way of punishment imposed upon him after a Court of Inquiry was conducted and he was treated as a deserter. Even in the documents filed by the applicant with regard to his discharge, he is shown to have been dismissed in terms of the statutory provisions. Once the Pension Regulations debar a dismissed employee from claiming pension, we see no reason to ignore the statutory provisions and grant pension to the applicant. The applicant can claim pension only after the disqualification attached to his dismissal or removal is removed. So long as the discharge or order of removal subsists, ignoring the same and in violation of the statutory provisions contained in Para 41 of the Revised Pension Regulations for the Army Part I (2008), pensionary benefits cannot be granted to the applicant. On being questioned as to whether the applicant has challenged the dismissal order, the counsel for the applicant was unable to respond to the query in a positive manner. On the contrary, in the pleadings available on record, there is nothing to indicate that the applicant had ever challenged his dismissal or removal from service and thereafter now as if the disqualification attached to his removal or dismissal is wiped out, he is claiming pension.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, as the statutory provisions debar grant of pension to the applicant, in this application in exercise of the jurisdiction under Section 14 of the AFT Act we cannot grant any relief to the applicant. The O A is devoid of merit and is dismissed. No order as to costs.
